I invite you to carefully read our revised student uniform policy that will go into effect for the 2020-2021 school year. You will find that the policy includes more choices and options, including the option to purchase the khaki pants at a lower price from French Toast, and a sweatpant/sweatshirt PE option for students in grades 6-8. Please also note that black pants are no longer an option, and we have added the option of leggings for girls. We are excited to announce that students in Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd grades are no longer required to wear dress shoes but are instead required to wear much more comfortable (and safe) sneakers in solid black color. Finally, take note that sneakers for all other students may be worn for PE and must be solid black or white with matching shoelaces. Walmart, Burlington, and Target carry many varieties of solid colored black and white shoes. Shoes with patterns are not permitted.

Please note that Flynn & O'Hara is currently offering free shipping and discounts of up to 20%. I recommend you take advantage of this unusual sale, as the discount will likely disappear in August.
