

Dear Families,

After much thought and prayer, I have made a decision regarding the closing of school for Christmas and the reopening again in January. This decision is based on how to best keep our entire school community safe and healthy.

Our last day of in person instruction will be December 11, with an early dismissal of 11:30 a.m. and no Extended Day. We will transition all instruction to remote learning on December 14, and our last day of remote learning before Christmas will be December 21 - now a full day. We will resume remote instruction on January 4, and in person instruction will begin on January 11.

Your child's teacher is well prepared to make this transition smoothly and successfully. Please support our efforts by checking your email daily and encouraging your child to stay focused and caught up on school work. The expectation is that your child will complete all assigned work and be prepared to move forward upon returning to school in person on January 11.

You will find a tutorial video for the use of Schoology during remote learning on your child's teacher's Weebly site which can be found on the school website faculty and staff page. In addition, Mrs. Lane, Technology Coordinator, is available should you have any questions.

Mrs. Santay will contact My Hot LunchBox, and families who have preordered lunches will be issued a credit. Ordering lunch will resume on January 11.
