We have been very strict with our guidelines and protocols at St. Patrick School, and it has paid off. We have remained open and free of any Covid outbreak. Students will use Schoology to log in each day April 12-16 to complete daily assignments. Students will return to in-school learning on Monday, April 19.

Please recall that during online learning, students are required to login to Schoology by 9:00 a.m. daily. Attendance is required daily. All work should be completed daily so that your child does not fall behind.

Our primary goal at the school is to minimize the impact of student/family high risk activity and travel on the community spread of COVID-19. I ask that you not extend your Easter Break past April 11. This will allow all of us to have one week back at home to quarantine prior to returning to school on April 19. If you cannot adhere to these guidelines, please contact the school office. Your child will need to utilize our remote hybrid learning program for the extra week required before returning to school.
